Community Outreach Efforts

- 1) WNRN recruits and retains volunteers for on air shifts. The training of volunteers starts with voice tracking. This includes learning the contents and order of a break, and work towards a conversational style while going through the scripts and branding statements. Once well versed in voice tracking and has a command of break elements, volunteers are trained to do an on-air shift. All volunteers must understand the FCC requires of a transmitter operator. Volunteers are critiqued by staff to improve their overall on-air performance.
- 2) Our on-going semester internship program welcomes students from area universities and colleges who are motivated and excited about learning and contributing to community radio. Their internship is endorsed, supported and monitored by the sponsoring university. Students receive course credit for their work with WNRN upon completion of each semester. WNRN offers internships for spring, summer and fall semesters. During this reporting period, WNRN has had four student interns. Two internships for the summer, and two internships for the fall. WNRN interns learn administrative and marketing skills, help manage our music and winner databases, create Facebook events, edit podcasts, and update the WNRN website.
- 3) WNRN encourages station employees to attend training conferences and events hosted by non-commercial radio trade or music organizations. Conferences were cancelled or held virtually this year due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
